CLASSROOM AND OTHER VIDEOS – DESCRIPTIONS

1. The Story of America's Liberty
An examination of the men and events that were significant in the founding of America. The guiding hand of God is clearly seen through these events. Emphasis is placed upon trusting God and using His principles to govern a nation. (57 min.)
2. The Evolution Conspiracy
A documentary presenting the Creation/Evolution debate in an appealing format featuring some of the most influential experts on both sides. Evolution is contrasted with the scientific facts supporting creation with a solid basis for faith in the Creator. (48 min.)
3. Gods of the New Age
A documentary that explains why yoga, meditation, psychological therapy, and self-help are turning millions to a pagan world view and how the west is being intentionally evangelized by eastern mystics and New Age visionaries. It tracks the progression from an early sixties planning meeting held by Indian gurus to today's dignified U. S. corridors, American schoolrooms, and Christian churches. (103 min.)
4. Asbestos Awareness
A two-hour training video on asbestos awareness which satisfies the annual AHERA requirements for schools which have ACM (Asbestos Containing Materials). (120 min.)
5. America's Godly Heritage – David Barton, Wallbuilders
A discussion of the beliefs of many of the famous Founding Fathers concerning the proper role of Christian Principles in education, in government, and in the public affairs of the nation. Excerpts from court cases showing that for 160 years Christian principles were officially and legally inseparable from American public life are included. (59 min.)
6. Education and the Founding Fathers – David Barton, Wallbuilders
An examination of the educational beliefs and practices of our Founding Fathers, including information on the schools they attended and the textbooks used. The video discusses how far we have strayed from their specific plans to maintain a successful educational system and what can be done to return to their original blueprint. (60 min.)
7. U. S. Education – Contest of Cultures – Donna Hearn, Constitutional Coalition
Donna Hearn, Executive Director of the Constitutional Coalition and a former official of the U. S. Department of Education under the Reagan administration, discusses Outcome Based Education. Although somewhat technical for viewing by parents, it gives excellent background information on OBE.
8. What's Behind the Rock: Rock Music and the Occult – Rev. David Benoit
Explanation, description, and illustrations of the relationship between rock music and the occult. For use in Bible classes, chapel services, Sunday school classes, etc. Study guides are available from Rev. Benoit. (85 min.)
9. When God Calls the New World to Order – Rev. David Benoit
Description of Globalism: The Political Agenda of the New World Order. Included are the relationship of environmentalism, secular education, and the recent re-writing of history texts to Globalism. (60 min.)
10. HIV/AIDS Awareness, Prevention Program – SafetyLine
To be used for faculty/staff training on HIV/AIDS/Hepatitis B awareness and protection. Can be used in conjunction with the manual which is available through the GACS office. Even though this video is made primarily for public school use, nearly all of it applies to private and Christian schools. Before it is shown to faculty and staff members, it should be viewed by the administrator so he/she can be aware of probable questions. (27 min.)
11. Protecting Yourself from Bloodborne Viruses at School
In-service training video for instructional use by teachers and other school personnel. Good information on protection from exposure to bloodborne viruses. Can be used in connection with the *Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure Control Plan*. (15 min.)
12. The Tabernacle and the Day of Atonement – AVM Presentations
Excellent teaching tool for Bible class or chapel displaying the Biblical background of the Tabernacle and Day of Atonement. The presentation helps viewers to understand these important topics. Good for classroom use allowing time for discussion. (28 min.)
13. Temple of the Lost Ark – Day of Discovery
Filmed in Israel, this video on Bible prophecy deals with the temples of Scripture, plans which are underway for the rebuilding of the temple, and other prophetic passages on the Second Coming. Radio Bible Class (Day of Discovery) production. (Four programs of 30 min. each. Total of 2 hours.)
14. GACS Accreditation Training Program – Dr. Phil Suiter
A training session by Dr. Phil Suiter, Accreditation Commissioner of the American Association of Christian Schools. This session discusses the accreditation standards emphasized by GACS and AACCS. Even though the training, presented at the GACS Pastors and Administrators Seminar in 1994, is primarily directed to those who may serve on accreditation teams, it is of much value to administrators and teachers of schools which are considering GACS accreditation. (150 min.)
15. Crisis in the Classroom (Hidden Agendas) – Phyllis Schlafly
A description of Outcome Based Education and its dangers. Includes growing grassroots opposition to OBE. Television special report hosted by Phyllis Schlafly. (58 min.)
16. Everything You Wanted to Know about HIV/AIDS But Were Too Afraid to Ask – Jerry Thacker
Contains the basic facts about HIV infection. Excellent to use as a general teaching tool for educating schools and churches about the disease. (45 min.)
17. When AIDS Comes Home – Jerry Thacker
True story of how a Christian family is suddenly struck by the AIDS virus. Attacks the common stereotypes of AIDS victims and calls upon Christians to respond mercifully and with grace. (45 min.)
